

## Konica Minolta celebrates Earth Day with Plant-A-Tree, launches new CSR program

**Monday, April 25, 2016** – In commemoration of Earth Day on April 23, leader in print and enterprise content management Konica Minolta Business Solutions Asia (BSA) took part in the Garden City Fund's Plant-A-Tree Programme. The company also took the opportunity to announce its new 'I AM CSR' corporate social responsibility (CSR) programme to improve employee volunteerism rates in the company. The tree planting activity is the first volunteer initiative to be launched under the programme.

A total of 24 volunteers from Konica Minolta BSA, planted 20 *Melaleuca bracteata* 'Revolution Gold' tree saplings at Bedok Town Park on 23 April 2016.
